Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons to register for Full-Time and Part-Time study tenable at St Montfort (Chiradzulu) and St Thomas More (Lilongwe) Campuses.

The closing date for receiving completed application forms is **Friday, 6th November 2026 for Full-Time Programmes** and **Friday, 11th December 2026** for Weekend Programmes.

Eligible applicants will sit for University Entrance Examinations on **Saturday, 21st November, 2026** starting at **8 a.m.**

Entrance Examinations for Full-Time candidates will be administered at the following centres: **St. Montfort Campus (Nguludi); St. Thomas More Campus (Lilongwe); and St. Mary's Secondary School (Mzuzu)**. Any changes of examination venues will be communicated.

University Entrance Examinations will consist of three papers: **Reasoning Skills; Numerical Skills; and English & Communication Skills.**
